## By-Law 1

### VOTING RIGHTS

#### 1. Interpretation

Where not inconsistent with the context, words which are defined in the Constitution of The Real Estate Institute of New South Wales Limited ACN 000 012 457 (**REINSW** or **Institute**) have the same meanings in these By-Laws as they have in the definitions of the Constitution.

Capitalised terms in these By-Laws are defined in REINSW's Constitution and By-Law 2 – Membership.
